Year 4 Segedunum Visit

Year 4 will be visiting Segedunum on **Tuesday 3 February 2026**. On the trip the children will take part in two exciting workshops, Boudica's Britannia and a Roman Life Tour, as well as exploring the Roman fort. The learning experience will consolidate the children's understanding of their Spring 1 History topic *Roman Britain*, as well as prepare them for their Summer 1 History topic where we will explore the Roman impact on our local area.

We will leave at 9.00am and return by 3.00pm, travelling by Metro. Children must wear their full school uniform and have a waterproof jacket, water bottle (no glass), packed lunch and bag. Please remember not to include any products with nuts or any fizzy drinks in the packed lunch.

We require 4 parent volunteers to accompany us on this trip. If you are available to help, I would be grateful if you could contact the school office **no later than 3pm on Friday 23 January 2026**. A short meeting will be held on the morning of the trip to discuss safety protocols, in line with our risk assessment. If we are over-subscribed for volunteers, names will be drawn out of a hat to allow the process to be fair for all interested parties.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of **£7.00** per child towards the cost of the workshop and transport. All contributions should be paid via Arbor. Please contact the office if you have any further questions about the trip.
