Footwear as Part of OPAL Play

As part of our school's OPAL Play (Outdoor Playtime and Learning) journey, we are offering more playtime options at lunchtime such as den building and the Forest School.

For these activities to happen, each child will need to wear appropriate clothing to keep them dry and warm. Every child should bring in a named warm, waterproof coat and a pair of either named wellington boots or old trainers to change into. On PE days, children will still require a change of footwear. This is to stop children getting their school shoes dirty or damaged and to limit disruptions in afternoon lessons due to wet feet or muddy classrooms.

The wellington boots/old trainers will stay in school but will be available to take home during school holidays if required. The children will need coats every day as the weather can change and, as part of OPAL Play, we are wanting the children to access the outdoors as much as possible.
