### **Year 2 Whitehouse Farm School Trip**

Year 2 will be visiting Whitehouse Farm on **Thursday 25 May 2023**. On the trip the children will have an accompanied tour of the farm meeting the animals and learning all about how the farm operates. The learning experience is linked to our Literacy topic of 'recounts' as we will be writing about our experience afterwards. The trip will also be a well-earned treat after completing KS1 SATS.

There is a voluntary contribution of **£13.00** per child, payable on ParentPay, to cover the cost of the visit and transport.

We will leave at 9.40am and return by 3.00pm, travelling by coach. Children must wear their full school uniform. Trainers may be worn. Dependent on the weather, children may need a waterproof coat and a sun hat.

We need 4 parent volunteers to accompany us on this trip. If you are available to help, I would be grateful if you could contact the school office **no later than 3pm on Wednesday 10 May**. A short meeting will be held on the morning of the trip to discuss safety protocols, in line with our risk assessment. If we are over-subscribed for volunteers, names will be drawn out of a hat to allow the process to be fair for all interested parties.

As Year 2 children are entitled to universal income free school meals, all children can receive a packed lunch from school. If you would like school to provide a packed lunch, please complete the sheet attached and return it to school by **Wednesday 10 May**. Alternatively, you can provide your child with a packed lunch from home. Please note this on the sheet and return.
