Year 1 Gosforth Nature Reserve Trip - Thursday 27 April

Year 1 will be visiting Gosforth Nature Reserve on **Thursday 27 April**. On the trip the children will explore Mini Beasts and Pond Dipping activities. The learning experience is linked to our Science topic of 'Seasonal Changes'.

There is a voluntary contribution of £7.50 per child, payable on ParentPay, to cover the cost of the transport.

We will leave at 9.30am and return by 12.30pm, travelling by coach. As we return to school during the lunch break, children will then be able to have a school meal. Therefore, children **do not require** a packed lunch for this trip.

Children must wear their full school uniform. Trainers or alternative footwear for outdoors may be worn. Dependent on the weather, children may need a waterproof jacket and a sun hat. Children must also bring a water bottle with them.

We need 4 parent volunteers to accompany us on this trip. If you are available to help, I would be grateful if you could contact the school office **no later than 10am Monday 24th April**. A short meeting will be held on the morning of the trip to discuss safety protocols in line with our risk assessment. If we are over-subscribed for volunteers, names will be drawn out of a hat to allow the process to be fair for all interested parties.
