SafetyWorks!

Year 6 will be attending a half-day session at Tyne and Wear Fire and Rescue Service's interactive safety centre, SafetyWorks! on **Monday 17 February**.

SafetyWorks! is a facility managed and operated by Tyne and Wear Fire and Rescue Service in conjunction with partner agencies. The centre provides realistic and interactive scenarios which enable practical learning in a safe, controlled environment. This will help raise the children's awareness in different aspects of fire safety, personal safety, home safety and travel safety. The workshops will be interactive for the pupils and the aim of the project is to raise awareness in how to stay safe and provide them the skills to avoid accidents and reduce accidental injuries.

There is a voluntary contribution of **£5 per child**, payable on ParentPay, to cover the cost of the workshop and transport. We will leave school at 9.30am and return by 12.00pm, travelling by coach and will have lunch once we have returned to school.

We will need 2 parent volunteers to accompany us on this trip. If you are available to help, I would be grateful if you could contact the school office **no later than 3pm on Monday 10 February**. If we are over-subscribed for volunteers, names will be drawn out of a hat to allow the process to be fair for all interested parties.
